Hello everybody,

In English, we are working on the 'l' sound, moving onto the 'or' sound towards the end of week 9. We will be writing stories to be published with the theme of '*Two Worlds Meeting*'.

Parent Participation:

Seeing as reading groups start at different times in the morning, I am sending out a less time specific invite than in the previous newsletter. Our class is always open to any parents coming to listen to children read during any morning sessions any morning of the week. Even if you have 10 minutes, we can work with that!

For Maths we are looking at number patterns, which involve working out if there is an addition, subtraction, or multiplication pattern in number sequences. Students have been keen to use an interactive number chart to help them solve these types of problems so far to help spot patterns. We will also be looking at chance and data, and time to finish off the term.

In History, we will continue to explore 'two worlds meeting' with the story of William Buckley, an escaped convict who ended up spending 32 years of his life with the Wathaurong people in the early 1800s. He claimed to have seen a bunyip which has created some very interesting discussion amongst our class.



Lastly, *a heads up for next term's camp at Fingal Head in Week 4 on the 17th, 18th and 19th of May*. Details such as time off work, who is driving whom, trailer driving, and such are things that are best given attention sooner than later. We will be combining the camp with the Guruman class.
